COSTS

\$450 per team for 3 games:

- \$100 registration fee to place your team in the Masters Cricket Festival (subject to availability).
- Balance of payment, \$350 to be paid prior to the start of Festival

RULES

- 20, 30 and 40 overs per team
- 11 players per team on ground at any one time
- All players must be over 35 years of age on Monday 15th January 2018
- A maximum of 7 overs for any one bowler (40 overs)
A maximum of 5 overs for any one bowler (30 overs)
A maximum of 3 overs for any one bowler (20 overs)
- Limited run up of 10 metres
- Retired batsmen must come back into bat in the order they retired. No changing order.
- Last man gets his tucker, bats with runner and if either is run out the teams innings is over
- Each team must wear standard cricket whites or an approved cricket uniform as agreed to by the organising committee
- A player can only play for 1 team per round
- Under age (35) players are not permitted on the field unless agreed to by the opposing team
- A total squad of no more than 14 players can be used for the Festival

INSURANCE

All teams are recommended to carry adequate personal and medical insurance to cover any loss of property, injuries, medical treatment or hospitalisation. The organising committee, ground operators and Festival officials will not be responsible for any claims, costs, proceedings and damages whatsoever and however arising directly or indirectly out of, or in connection with its participation in the Masters Cricket Festival at Barooga.

PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be distributed depending on the number of entries. In most cases prize money will be suitably proportioned to the top 4 teams. Prize for most runs, 'Master Blaster' and most wickets, Master Bowler. The event will only go ahead with a minimum number of teams.

GROUNDS & EQUIPMENT

All matches will be played on turf wickets. All teams should provide their own cricket playing equipment. Cricket balls, stumps and bails will be provided at all venues.
